Position: Preschool Teacher Assistant

Accountable to: The preschool teacher assistant is accountable to their lead teacher and the

Principal.

Purpose: Preschool teacher assistants will assist the teacher in providing a warm,

nurturing, Christ- centered, safe and loving environment where children's faith is nurtured and where self-concepts are enhanced, independence is encouraged

and individuality is respected.

Duties and Responsibilities:

As an educational leader at St. James Lutheran Preschool I will:

- 1. Assist the classroom teacher in supervision and management of a group of children.
- 2. Interact with, initiate and encourage children in daily activities.
- 3. Help children control behavior using a Christ-centered, positive, consistent approach.
- 4. Help children grow to become independent.
- 5. Help prepare the learning environment, setting up interest centers and preparing materials.
- 6. Assist the teacher in record keeping and observations related to children's development, health and behavior.
- 7. Assist with serving and distribution of snacks.
- 8. Promote integral learning during snack times.
- 9. Help with general housekeeping tasks. Sweeping floors, wiping down tables and chairs.
- 10. Attend to the needs of individual children with sensitivity.
- 11. Attend required staff meetings and functions of St. James Lutheran School and Preschool.
- 12. Help build a supportive, caring team.
- 13. Assist the teacher in other ways as needed including to ileting children and helping with accidents.
- 14. Supervise conscientiously, keeping primary focus on the children.

Qualifications:

- 1. Minimum of high school education or equivalent, with some training in early childhood preferred.
- 2. Must be able to communicate effectively verbally and in writing.
- 3. Experience in child care, preschool work or any equivalent combination of experience and training which provides the following knowledge, abilities and skills:
 - a. Working knowledge of developmentally appropriate behaviors for preschool children.
 - b. Relates well with younger children.
 - c. Ability to relate to preschool age children with appropriate vocabulary and mannerisms.
- 4. Continue to advance professionally through workshops and staff development.

Physical Requirements: One needs to have the physical and emotional stamina required for teaching in the classroom.
